

Remote Access to H: Drive and Academic Shares from a Mac - STUDENTS

First you must ensure that your Mac is connected to the internet through your Internet Service Provider (ISP), then click on the VPN connection icon at the top right of the screen ...



... and then choose *Connect SLC VPN* from the drop-down menu.

Once the VPN connection is established, from the desktop *Finder* menu click *Go* and choose *Connect to Server*.

To Remotely Access the Academic Share of an SLC Instructor

To gain access to an *Academic Share*, you must enter the correct path. The path you key in will depend on which St. Lawrence College campus you attend and which instructor's share you want to access. Use the following as a guide:

Brockville	smb://BNAS01.SL.ON.CA/AcademicShares/Brockville/PBrown
Cornwall	smb://CFS02.SL.ON.CA/AcademicShares/Cornwall/JSmith
Kingston	afp://KNAS01.SL.ON.CA/AcademicShares/Kingston/LJones

Based on the table above, enter the appropriate server address and click *Connect*.

Before being connected to the server, you will be required to authenticate:

- The *Workgroup or Domain* field must contain SL.
- In the *Name* and *Password* fields enter your network account user name and password.
- Since your network password is changed regularly, de-select the *Remember this password in my keychain option*.

Click *OK*.

When you are asked to *Select the volume you want to connect to*, click the double-headed arrow and choose *AcademicShares* from the drop-down list. Click *OK*.

To Remotely Access Your Home Directory

To gain access to your *Home Directory*, you must enter the correct path. The path you key in will depend on which St. Lawrence College campus you attend. Use the following as a guide:

Brockville	smb://BNAS01.SL.ON.CA/Homedir/JDoe21
Cornwall	smb://CFS02.SL.ON.CA/Homedir/MJones30
Kingston	afp://KNAS01.SL.ON.CA/Homedir/JMichael15
