

How to Remotely Access the Academic Share of an SLC Instructor

Connect to the Internet, then connect to the SLC VPN server. To gain access to an *Academic Share*, you must enter the correct path in the *Run* dialog box. The path you key in will depend on which St. Lawrence College campus you attend and which instructor's share you want to access. Use the following as a guide:

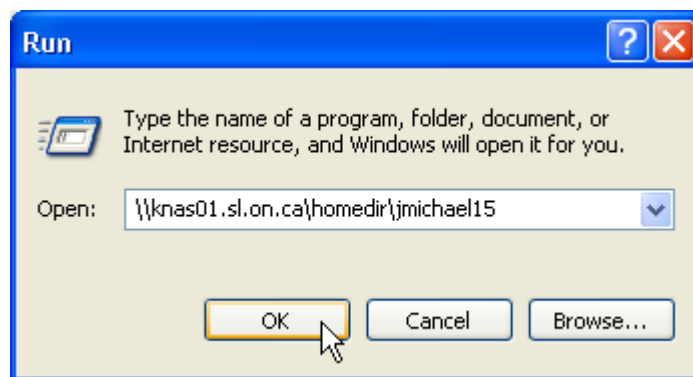
Campus	Sample Paths
Brockville	\\BNAS01.SL.ON.CA\AcademicShares\Brockville\PBrown
Cornwall	\\CFS02.SL.ON.CA\AcademicShares\Cornwall\JSmith
Kingston	\\KNAS01.SL.ON.CA\AcademicShares\Kingston\LJones

How to Remotely Access Your Home Directory

Connect to the Internet, then connect to the SLC VPN server. From the *Start* menu select *Run...* and the *Run* dialog box will appear. In order to gain access to your home directory, you must enter the correct path in the *Run* dialog box - and the path you key in will depend on which St. Lawrence College campus you attend. Use the following as a guide:

Campus	Sample Paths
Brockville	\\BNAS01.SL.ON.CA\Homedir\JDoe21
Cornwall	\\CFS02.SL.ON.CA\Homedir\MJones30
Kingston	\\KNAS01.SL.ON.CA\Homedir\JMichael15

So for Jon Michael, a student on Kingston campus with the username *JMichael15*, the *Run* dialog box would contain the path shown below. Click *OK*.



Important:

Be sure to specify your user name as part of the path. If you end the path with *\homedir*, the system will display a listing of all the *Homedir* folders on the specified server, and since there are *hundreds* of home directories – one for every St. Lawrence College student – that could take more than ½ hour! When the connection is successful, the content of your home directory will be displayed.
